Passenger's Code of Conduct

- A.) Passenger will conduct themselves in a manner that is not disruptive to the driver.
- B.) Passenger will wear provided seat belts at all times.
- C.) Passenger recognizes that the driver has the authority to ultimately remove any passenger that is disruptive causing the driver to be distracted. It is expected that all passengers will submit to the authority of the driver and cooperate with all established rules and regulations

Basic ground rules for retreats and events:

1. If you're not allowed to take it to school, you can't bring it to an event.
2. Guys must stay out of girls sleeping/changing areas at all times and vice versa.
3. Girls are not permitted to wear 2-piece swimsuits; some "Tankini's" may be approved.
4. Guys are to wear shirts unless activity permits (i.e. swimming); leaders will have discretion.
5. If you are driving to or from an event, you need parental permission prior to the event. While at the event, no teen is permitted to drive anywhere.
6. Everyone is expected to participate in all scheduled activities.
7. Respect must be granted towards all: teens, leaders, rules, and property.
8. Disrespect/Disobedience may lead to a parental contact.
9. No physical PDA's (Public or Private Display of Affection) between opposite sexes.
